PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS: the discovery and development of one's talents for the good of society is essential to personal fulfillment, and the right to choose one's occupation is a basic American freedom, and
- WHEREAS: the structure of occupations and industries is changing so rapidly and radically that most individuals will make one or more occupational changes in their lifetimes, and
- WHEREAS: career guidance has proved to be a vital bridge between the increasingly complex world of work and the individual's need to select, locate and train for employment that is congenial and rewarding.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of October 22 - 28, 1972, as

CAREER GUIDANCE WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to observe the week by making themselves better acquainted with the services offered by professional counselors.
