PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: the Jewish National Fund has since its inception in 1901 been the valued and devoted servant of the Jewish People in first purchasing and then redeeming the Holy Soil of Israel, and

WHEREAS: the Jewish National Fund has planted more than 100,000,000 trees to ameliorate the soil, anchor the sand dunes, provide climate control, insure proper irrigation and stand as wind-breaks protecting young crops, and

WHEREAS: the Jewish National Fund has established close to seven hundred colonies and outposts throughout the land, populated by more than 450,000 people, and

WHEREAS: the Jewish National Fund has built more than 2100 kilometers of access and border roads forming a network of viable communication links throughout the length and breadth of the land of Israel, and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Council of the Jewish National Fund has seen fit to honor, on October 29, 1972, Mr. and Mrs. Rudolph Miller, two distinguished Minnesotans, for their dedication to all humanitarian causes and their devotion to the Jewish People and the land of Israel,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of October 29, 1972 as

JEWISH NATIONAL FUND WEEK

in Minnesota and commend the Jewish National Fund as being worthy of the support of the citizens of Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this tenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two and of the State, the one hundred sixteenth.
