each individual, whether handicepped or of normal capacity, has the basic human right to remain with his family and in his own community whenever possible and to share in all of the daily life events with all other members of the family and community;

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Day Activity Center program was created out of concern for the welfare of mentally retarded persons who cannot participate fully in many existing community services and activities; and

WHEREAS: this program has been fostered and given strength by the people of Minnesota, by the State Legislature, and through the special concern of the Minnesota Association for Retarded Children and the Minnesota Day Activity Center Association; and

more than 2,000 mentally retarded children and adults are now WHEREAS: receiving the benefits of the guidance and special activities of this program in 125 Day Activity Centers located in more than 45 Minnesota countles; and

this program is effectively contributing to a greater Quality WHEREAS: of Life for Minnesote citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wondell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, November 9, 1972 as

## DAY ACTIVITY CENTER DAY

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to join in recognizing our continuing responsibilities to all mentally retorded persons and to rededicate our offorts to their continued welfare during this special observance honoring the Daytime Activity Centers of this state and those dedicated volunteers and staff involved in this program admirably domonstrating the desired degree of human concern.
