WHEREAS: Nordic skiing combines the cross-country and jumping aspects of the sport, thus requiring a unique blend of strength and skill, and is gaining rapidly in popularity in Minnesota and across our country, and

WHEREAS: the United States Ski Association cross-country Championships were last held in Minnesota in 1936, and

WHEREAS: the United States Ski Association National Championships in Cross-Country and Nordic Combined will be held at Bryant Lake Park in Bloomington, Minnesota, from January 28 through February 4, 1973, and

WHEREAS: more than 100 of the United States' finest skiers, including the entire U. S. Olympic Team, will compete in these championships,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare January 28 through February 4, 1973

as

NORDIC SKI WEEK

in Minnesota.
