WHEREAS: the week of January 21 through 27 celebrates the founding of the Junior Chamber of Commerce in 1915 when Henry Glessenbier saw a need for a young men's civic group and organized the first chapter, and

WHEREAS: the Junior Chamber of Commerce was built on the foundation of creating opportunities for leadership training through human involvement and community betterment projects, and

WHEREAS: today, the Jaycees are over 300,000 strong and active in 6,000 communities in the United States; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Jaycees, in more than 200 communities throughout the state, continue to make contributions to community development in many fields, and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Jaycees are providing needed support in the areas of corrections and venereal disease, both of which are of concern in Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 21 through 27, as

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be cognizant of the work the Jaycees are doing to make their communities and Minnesota a better place for all of us to live.
