WHEREAS: the work of Dr. Robert Alan Good as a teacher has inspired and stimulated many talented young Minnesotans to pursue careers in medicine, in medical research and in biology, and

WHEREAS: Dr. Robert Alan Good has attracted to the University of Minnesota outstanding scientists from the world over, thus adding greatly to the University's international renown as a medical research, teaching and clinical study center, and

WHEREAS: the dedication and brilliance of Dr. Robert Alan Good over the past quarter of a century has greatly benefitted the people of his State and all mankind,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, January 12, 1973 as

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to join in honoring this distinguished native son on his departure from the University of Minnesota to become President and Director of the Sloan-Kettering Institute in New York City.
