AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WINNEBAGO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UN-INCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, A certain petition dated July 14, 1972 requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described, was duly presented to the Village Clerk on August 16, 1972, and

WHEREAS, The quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 8.42 acres, more or less, of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough, and

WHEREAS, The petition was signed by the following owners: Raymond Marsh and Elizabeth Marsh, and Condux International, Inc., a Minnesota corporation, by Paul W. Radichel, its Vice President, and James W. Seifert, its Assistant Secretary, and

WHEREAS, No objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and the Town Board of the Township of Verona, and the County Board of the County of Faribault have both consented in writing to said petition, and

WHEREAS, The land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits of the Village of Winnebago at the boundaries thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Village of Winnebago, Minnesota ordains:

- (1) That the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected.
- (2) That the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is, or is about to become urban or suburban in character.
- (3) That none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.
- (4) That the corporate limits of the Village of Winnebago are hereby extended to include the land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter of Section 3 in Township 103 North, Range 28 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Faribault County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3, thence South 0 degrees - 00 minutes, - 00 seconds East (assumed bearing) along the East line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3 a distance of 1025.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing South O degrees - 00 minutes - 00 seconds East along the East line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3 a distance of 400.00 feet (said course lying along the Corporate Limits of the Village of Winnebago), thence North 89 degrees - 08 minutes - 00 seconds West a distance of 1064.87 feet to a point on the Southeasterly right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad (said right-of-way line being 50.00 feet, measured at right angles, from the centerline of the railroad track), thence North 36 degrees - 45 minutes - 30 seconds East along the Southeasterly railroad right-of-way line a distance of 493.52 feet, thence South 89 degrees - 08 minutes-00 seconds East a distance of 769.54 feet to the point of beginning.

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- (5) The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Clerk of Verona Township, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor of Faribault County, Minnesota.
- (6) That this Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies, as directed.
