EXTRACT OF MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE
VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCKVILLE
STEARNS COUNTY, MINNESOTA

A regular meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Rockville, Stearns County, Minnesota, was held at the Village Hall in said village on Wednesday, the 6th day of December, 1972, commencing at 7:00 o'clock, P. M.

The following members were present: Mayor Al J. Maselter,
Councilman Edward Kahl, Wilfred Sauer, Eugene Rothstein & Clerk Michael Weissman
and the following were absent: NONE

Michael Weissman reported to the council Attorney Stephen Lickteig had served notice of the petition for annexation of land to the village, which had been submitted to the council by Ronald M. Taufen et al, by mailing copies of the petition, on September 29, 1972, to the Stearns County Board of Commissioners, addressed to Arnold Hinnenkamp, Stearns County Auditor; the Rockville Town Board, addressed to Pierre Hansen, Clerk of Rockville Township; and to The Minnesota Municipal Commission, and that no objection to the petition had been filed by any of said bodies, with either the Mayor, Clerk or the Village attorney, and that the Village Attorney had received acknowledgment from the Minnesota Municipal Commission stating the petition was in order.

Thereupon, Councilman Eugene Rothstein introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCKVILLE TO
INCLUDE UNPLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE
LIMITS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Rockville,
Minnesota, the following ordinance is hereby adopted as Ordinance No. 29,
the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the same, and the Clerk is
directed to make arrangements for publication of the same in the St. Cloud Daily
Times, to-wit:

Ordinance No. 29

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCKVILLE
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200
ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition, dated September 27, 1972, requesting annex-
ation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the
27th day of September, 1972, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the
petition and bounded as described is approximately 12.75 acres of unplatted land,
no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or
borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the owners of said land; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the
town board of Rockville Township, the Stearns County Board of Commissioners, or
the Minnesota Municipal Commission, said bodies having due notice as provided
by statute, and more than sixty (60) days having elapsed since such notice was
provided; and

WHEREAS the land described in the petition abuts the village limits at
the west boundary thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCKVILLE, MINNESOTA,
ORDAINS:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation
will be in the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the
territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is about to become urban
or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within
the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 17, Township 123 North, Range 29 West, Township of Rockville, Stearns County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter; thence South along the West line of said Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter a distance of 247.50 feet; thence East parallel to the North line of said Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter a distance of 820.80 feet to the point of beginning of the tract to be described; thence South parallel to said West line 221.58 feet; thence West parallel to said North line 589.80 feet; thence South parallel to said West line 188.57 feet; thence West parallel to said North line 231.00 feet to the West line of said Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter; thence South along said West line a distance of 254.58 feet; thence East parallel to said North line 820.80 feet; thence North parallel to said West line 188.57 feet; thence East parallel to said North line 492.73 feet to the East line of said Section 17; thence North along said East line to its intersection with a line which is parallel to and 247.50 feet South of the North line of said Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter as measured along the West line thereof; thence West along said parallel line to the point of beginning; said tract containing 12.75 acres, more or less.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Stearns County Auditor, and the clerk of the Township of Rockville.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage, publication, and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.



whereupon said resolution was declared duly passed and adopted.


