
OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to the Department of Labor and Industry and fix his compensation at the sum of Nineteen Thousand, Five Hundred (\$19,500) to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of Labor and Industry. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 10th day of January, 1973.




