WHEREAS, The Honorable Leo A. Reuther, Judge of the County Court of
Wilkin County, State of Minnesota, has heretofore filed with the undersigned
Governor of the State of Minnesota his written application for retirement, said
application being made under and pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes,
Section 490.12 (1971), and

WHEREAS, the said Judge Leo A. Reuther has submitted evidence that he
has attained the age of 72 years, and has served as such judge, or as such judge
and as such judge of a court of record, for more than 20 years,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of
Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of M.S. 490.12, do hereby order
and direct the retirement of the Honorable Leo A. Reuther, to become effective
at midnight on the 31st day of December, 1972. He shall become entitled there-
after to retirement compensation as provided under the law, and I further direct
that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of
Minnesota.


I have served as Probate and County Court Judge continuously since December 4, 1952, when I was appointed by the Honorable Governor C. Elmer Anderson.


Dear Judge Reuther:
