WHEREAS, The Honorable Ken Kalbrenner, Judge of the County Court of Wabasha County, State of Minnesota, has heretofore filed with the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota his written application for retirement, said application being made under and pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 490.12 (1971), and

WHEREAS, the said Judge Ken Kalbrenner has submitted evidence that he has attained the age of 65 years, and has served as such judge, or as such judge and as such judge of a court of record, for more than 24 years,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of M.S. 490.12, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Ken Kalbrenner, to become effective at midnight on the 28th day of February, 1973. He shall become entitled thereafter to retirement compensation as provided under the law, and I further direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.


