## Ordinance No. 115

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LINDSTROM TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY EORDERED ON THREE SIDES BY LAND WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS AND ABUTTING THEREON

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, 60% or more of the perimeter of this territory is bordered by lands already included within the corporate limits of the village and is deemed to be urban in character:

The village council of Lindstrom ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village of Lindstrom, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, 60% or more of the perimeter of which territory is bordered by territory already included within the village limits:

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

That part of Government Lot 6, Section 34, Township 34 North, Range 20 West, Chisago County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of lot 3, Block 1 of the recorded plat of Andrews Beach, Chisago County, Minnesota; thence on assumed bearing of North 88 degrees 02 minutes East, along the north line of said Andrews Beach, a distance of 673 feet, more or less, to a point on the westerly line of Irene Avenue; thence North 3 degrees 44 minutes West, along said Westerly line of Irene Avenue 340.45 feet to the point of beginning; thence Northwesterly along said Westerly line of Irene Avenue to a point 429 feet South of the Northerly line of Covernment Lot 6, as measured along the Mest line thereof: thence Easterly along said South line, a distance of 317 feet, more or less, to the shore line of North Center Lake; thence southeasterly along said shore line, a distance of 350 feet, more or less, to the Wayne Cartier island in North Center Lake; thence Southeasterly 30 feet, more or less, along said Westerly line to the shoreline of North Center Lake; thence Southwasterly along said shoreline 225 feet, more or less, to the point of intersection with a line that bears North 80 degrees 00 minutes East from the point of beginning; thence South 80 degrees 00 minutes West along said line a distance of 385 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning;

Section 2. Filing. The village clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect up on passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
