ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF TACONITE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the Village at the south boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban in character; and

WHEREAS, this territory is owned in fee by the Village;

The Village Council of Taconite ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Taconite are hereby extended to include the unplatted property described as follows now owned by the Village:

All that part of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-seven (27) in Township Fifty-six (56) North, Range Twenty-four (24) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, according to the United States Government survey thereof, bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 27, which point is 635.14 feet West of the Northeast corner thereof, measured along said North line, thence go South 3° 46' East a distance of 375 feet; thence go West on a straight line parallel to the North line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 27, to a point on the West line thereof; thence go North along the West line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 27 to the Northwest corner thereof, and thence go East along the North line thereof to the point of beginning, all in Itasca County, Minnesota.

Section 2. Filing. The village clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Itasca County, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.

## Affidavit of Publication

Douglas D. Deal, being duly sworn on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher of the newspaper known as the Scenic Range News and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second class matter in its post office. Said newspaper purports to serve the communities of Coleraine, Bovey, Taconite, Marble and Calumet and it has its known office of issue in the Village of Bovey in Itasca County, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by Douglas and Ethel Deal subject to their direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (5) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (6) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (7) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of the State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.


