AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF TACONITE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits

of any incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the Village at the south

boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban in character; and

WHREAS, this territory is owned in fee by the Village;

The Village Council of Taconite ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Taconite are

hereby extended to include the unplatted property described as follows now owned by the

Village:

All that part of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter (NW_4^2 of NW_4^2) of Section Twenty-seven (27) in Township Fifty-six (56) North, Range Twentyfour (24) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, according to the United States Government survey thereof, bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of the NW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ of said Section 27, which point is 635.14 feet West of the Northeast corner thereof, measured along said North line, thence go South 3° 46' East a distance of 375 feet; thence go West on a straight line parallel to the North line of the NW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ of said Section 27, to a point on the West line thereof; thence go North along the West line of the NW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ of said Section 27 to the Northwest corner thereof, and thence go East along the North line thereof to the point of beginning, all in Itasca County, Minnesota.

Section 2. Filing. The village clerk is directed to file certified copies of this

ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Itasca County, and the Minne-

sota Municipal Commission.
