

ORDINANCE NO. 136

JAN 12 1973

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WADENA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ LAND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, said petition was served upon the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the County of Wadena, and the Township of Wadena in addition to the village; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described is four and fifty-two hundredths (4.52) acres, more or less of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners constituting a majority; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, said petition was served upon the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the County of Wadena, and the Township of Wadena in addition to the village; and

WHEREAS, no objections were filed with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota to said annexation; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the southern boundary thereof;

The council of the Village of Wadena, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows:

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5) and Six (6) of Block Three (3) and Lots Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12) and Thirteen (13) of Block Four (4) of Southbrook, and all roads, streets and alleys adjacent thereto,

and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

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
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
Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the Secretary

of the newspaper known as THE WADENA PIONEER JOURNAL CO., INC., and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the Village of Wadena in the County of Wadena and it has its known office of issue in the Village of Wadena in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the managing officer of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and devoted exclusively during such regular business hours to the business the newspaper and business related thereto. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the managing officer of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

He further states on oath that the printed Ordinance No. 136

hereto attached as a part hereof was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein

in the English language, once each week, for one successive weeks;

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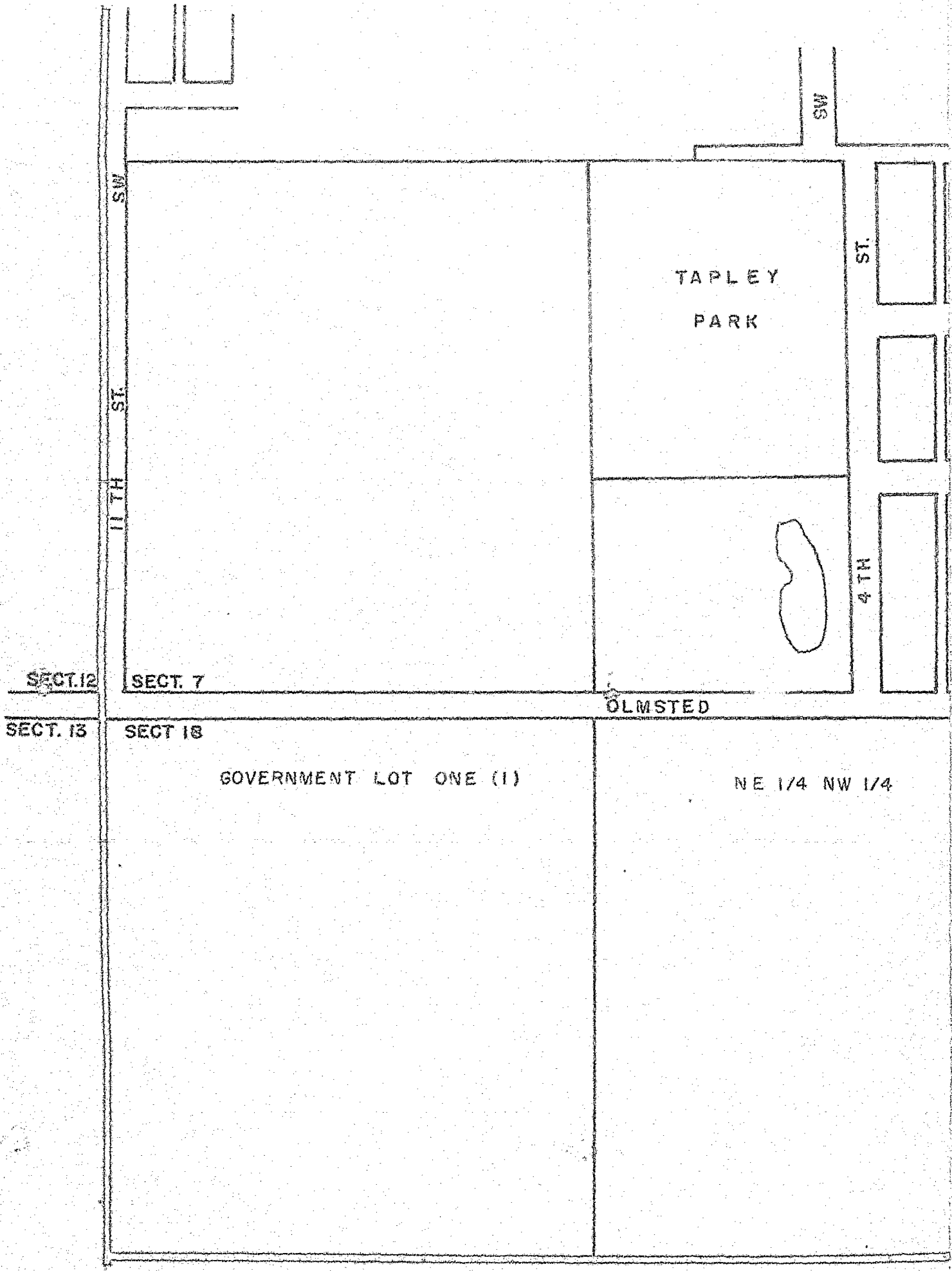

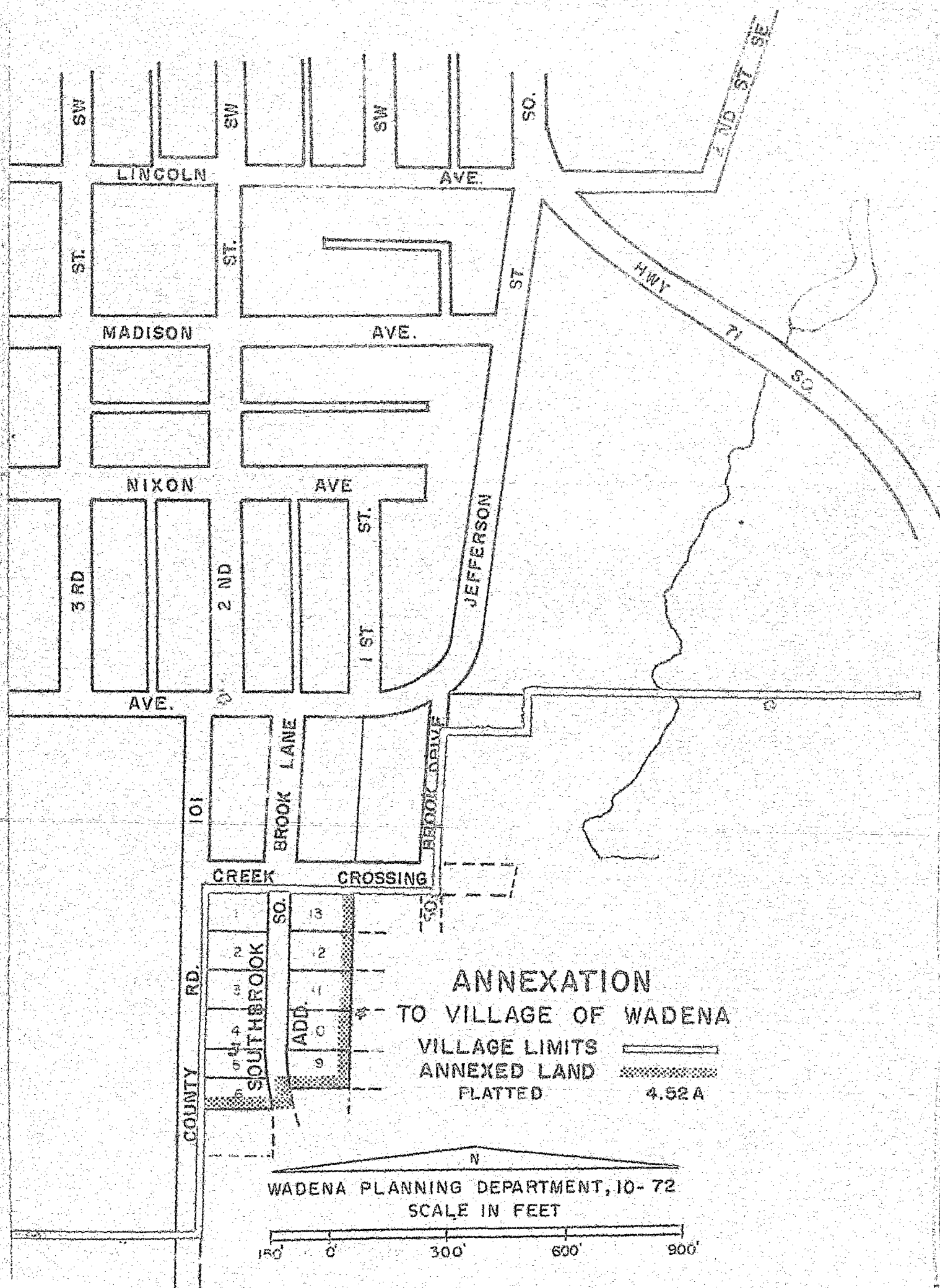
