PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, by Laws 1971, Chapter 958, there was proposed to the people of the state amendments to Article IV, Section 5, and Article V, Sections 1 and 6, providing for the election, duties, and compensation of the lieutenant governor. The proposed amendments read as follows:

"ARTICLE IV

Sec. 5. Each house shall elect its presiding officer and such other officers as may be provided by law; they shall keep journals of their proceedings, and from time to time publish the same, and the yeas and nays, when taken on any question, shall be entered on such journals.

ARTICLE V

Section 1. The executive department shall consist of a governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, auditor, treasurer and attorney general, who shall be chosen by the electors of the State. The governor and lieutenant governor shall be chosen jointly by a single vote applying to both offices, in a manner prescribed by law.

In case a vacancy should occur, from any cause Sec. 6. whatever, in the office of Governor, the lieutenant governor shall be Governor during such vacancy. The compensation of the lieutenant governor shall be prescribed by law. The last elected presiding officer of the Senate shall become lieutenant governor in case a vacancy should occur in that office. In case the Governor shall be unable to discharge the powers and duties of his office, the same shall devolve on the lieutenant governor. The legislature may by law provide for the case of the removal, death, resignation, or in-ability both of the Governor and lieutenant governor to discharge the duties of Governor and may provide by law for continuity of government in periods of emergency resulting from disasters caused by enemy attack in this state, including but not limited to, succession to the powers and duties of public office and change of the seat of government."

- AND WHEREAS, it appears from the official canvass of the votes cast at the election held on November 7, 1972, that the majority of the voters voting at the election voted for its adoption;
- NOW THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the state of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me, and in compliance with law do hereby publish and proclaim that said proposed amendments to Article IV, Section 5, and Article V, Sections 1 and 6 of the constitution of the state of Minnesota has been ratified and adopted as prescribed by the constitution and laws of the state.
