- WHEREAS: Quinto Aluni has earned the respect, esteem and affection of Virginia's citizens over many years; and
- WHEREAS: his outstanding career as a police officer and his concern for public safety has made Quinto Aluni a legend in his own time; and
- WHEREAS: Quinto Aluni has been identified with the American Red Cross since 1946 and twenty years ago was instrumental in requiring ARC first aid training for all state conservation employees; and
- WHEREAS: the American National Red Cross twice awarded Quinto Aluni the Certificate of Merit, its highest honor; and
- WHEREAS: other activities dear to the heart of Quinto Aluni include the St. Louis Safety Council, the Governor's Crime Commission, and the Knights of Columbus; and
- WHEREAS: Quinto Aluni is retiring as Virginia's Chief of Police and as a member of Virginia's police force after forty years of service;
