AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCHEDING TWO MUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, by the sole owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have the following described land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the East half (Eg) of Section Eight (8), in Township One Hundred Eleven (111) north, of Range Forty-one (41) west of the Fifth Principal Meridian described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the southwesterly corner of Lot 2, of Block 5, of Eatros Place, an addition to the City of Marshall, Minnesota, according to the recorded plat thereof in the office of the Register of Deeds of Lyon County, Minnesota, thence Westerly on an extension of the south line of said Block 5 of Eatros Place a distance of 186 feet; thence South and parallel with the west line of Cheryl Avenue in said City of Marshall, a distance of 576 feet; running thence West at right angles to last line a distance of 246 feet as the true place of beginning; running thence West on a continuation of last line a distance of 360 feet; running thence North at right angles to last line and parallel with the west line of said Cheryl Avenue to the southeasterly right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 23; running thence Northeasterly along the southeasterly right-of-way line of said Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 23 to a point due North of the true place of beginning; and running thence South and parallel with the west line of said Chryl Avenue to the true place of beginning, subject to existing easements.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described, is 2.2 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part hereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Lake Marshall Township, the County Auditor of Lyon County and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
