ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO THE INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that said Petition was signed by all the owners of said land and is suitable and proper in all respects; and

WHEREAS, copies of said Petition were duly forwarded on December 21, 1972, to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of the Township of Young America, the Carver County Board of Commissioners, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as required by law and rules of the Minnesota Municipal Commission; and

WHEREAS, more than 60 days have elapsed since the date of said filings and no objections have been made in writing, or otherwise, to the Village of Hamburg as to the annexation proposed by said Petition,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

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Section 1. <u>Declaration</u>. It is hereby determined that a copy of said Petititon was duly mailed as required by law and the rules and regulations of the Minnesota Municipal Commission to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of the Town of Young America, the Carver County Board of Commissioners, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and that no objection of the proposed annexation has been made by any of said parties or filed with the Village Council and that the territory described below abuts upon the present corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg; that said land does not exceed 200 acres in area; that said land is now now included in any other municipalities; that said land is conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government; and that annexation of said land would be in the best interest of the Village of Hamburg and the territory to be annexed.

Section 2. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. The corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg are hereby extended to encompass and embrace all the territory described as follows, to-wit:

That part of Government Lot 1 and Government Lot 2 of Section 28, Township 115 North, Range 26 West, described as follows:

Beginning at the most easterly corner of Lot 16, Bohlman's Addition, Hamburg, Minnesota, according to the recorded plat thereof; thence on a bearing of North 33 degrees 10 minutes 55 seconds East along the Northwesterly line of Brad Street in said Bohlman's Addition for a distance of 100.65 feet; thence on a bearing of North 50 degrees 12 minutes 40 seconds West, parallel with the Northeasterly line of said Lot 16, for a distance of 100.14 feet to the Southeasterly right of way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway; thence on a bearing of South 35 degrees 31 minutes 00 seconds West along the Southeasterly right of way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway for a distance of 100.26 feet to the most Northerly corner of said Lot 16; thence on a bearing of South 50 degrees 12 minutes 40 seconds East along the Northeasterly line of said Lot 16 for a distance of 104.25 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of the Town of Young America, the Carver County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as required by law.
