- WHEREAS: the 51st annual meeting of the Minnesota Home Economics Association will convene in Minneapolis, March 30 and 31; and
- WHEREAS: home economics is the field of knowledge and service primarily concerned with improving the quality of life for people through concern for the needs of individuals and families in their near environment; and
- WHEREAS: these needs are met through improving the goods and services used by individuals and families, educating people of all ages for effective living, furthering community, national and world conditions favorable to human development and conducting research to discover people's changing needs and means of satisfying those needs; and
- WHEREAS: home economists in Minnesota are making important contributions to both rural and urban families through teaching, business and extension service, as well as through participation in various international service programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 25 through March 31, 1973, as
