WHEREAS: Latin provides a foundation for the solving of the problems of today by studying their ancient counterparts; and

WHEREAS: students who wish to exercise their mind by means of a precise and disciplined study find the language of Latin an enjoyable and rewarding challenge for their pursuit; and

WHEREAS: through the study of Latin, a student can better orient himself toward a useful and satisfying life; and

WHEREAS: the Junior Classical League is an organization of young people who appreciate the civilization, language, literature, and art of ancient Greece and Rome; and

WHEREAS: as a result of their studies, members of the League have a better understanding of the debt our culture owes to that of classical antiquity; and

WHEREAS: the Twentieth Annual Minnesota Junior Classical League convention will be held at Anoka Senior High School on March 17, 1973;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 11 through March 17, 1973, as

LATIN WEEK

in Minnesota.
