WHEREAS: the cause of world peace, understanding and goodwill has recently been greatly enhanced by a group of young Americans visiting Communist China; and

WHEREAS: an invitation has now been extended by the Socialist Republic of Romania to the United States to send musical groups to visit their country in the summer of 1973; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Youth Symphony Orchestra composed entirely of teen-age musicians has been selected from forty competing groups from throughout the United States for their outstanding musical ability; and

WHEREAS: this trip will be financed entirely by the members of the orchestra, their friends and the citizens of local communities within our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 18 through March 24, 1973, as

MINNESOTA YOUTH SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens of our State to join in the support of this worthwhile project.
