

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS: wheat and wheat products are one of man's oldest crops and provide more nourishment for peoples of the world today than any other food; and
- WHEREAS: bread and baked goods are recognized as containing needed nutrients; and
- WHEREAS: a Congressional Resolution has been introduced to establish the fourth Saturday of March as National Bake and Take Day; and
- WHEREAS: on this day, through voluntary action, baked products of wheat and flour will be delivered to the elderly, shut-ins, and lonely; and
- WHEREAS: such volunteer action on the part of community, church, and service organizations will bring happiness to those less fortunate;

NOW, WHEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 24, 1973, as

MINNESOTA BAKE AND TAKE DAY

in Minnesota, and urge the citizens of our State to join in a national effort to voluntarily deliver baked goods to those less fortunate.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourteenth day of March in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three and of the State, the one hundred and fifteenth.
