WHEREAS: *Earth Week has come to symbolize the country's deep and continuing desire for environmental quality; and*

WHEREAS: *Earth Week serves as a focal point for environmental efforts throughout the country; and*

WHEREAS: *this year, Earth Week will encourage environmental education in specific areas: energy conservation, a cleaner working and living environment, the preservation of our forests, waters, and wildlife;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 9 through April 15, 1973, as

EARTH WEEK

in Minnesota, and earnestly request that our schools, communities and citizens participate in the search for solutions to our complex environmental problems.
