

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: *the State of Minnesota is noted for providing "The Good Life" for its residents and visitors and*

WHEREAS: *the State of Minnesota is continually reviewing its programs to help the mentally retarded of Minnesota to find their share of the good life through training in the use of their limited abilities to the fullest extent of those abilities and*

WHEREAS: *the people of Minnesota realize that the cost of training a mentally retarded person to do productive labor for wages is far less expensive than life-long institutional care and*

WHEREAS: *there are many programs sponsored by private citizens organizations to so aid the mentally retarded which are important adjuncts to the state's programs and*

WHEREAS: *Minnesota Honey Sunday is sponsored by the Minnesota Jaycees to so aid the mentally retarded*

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, April 29, 1973 as

MINNESOTA HONEY SUNDAY

and urge the good people of Minnesota to support this and other programs in their state and in their communities to aid the mentally retarded.
