- WHEREAS: *Minnesotans of Scandinavian ancestry have contributed in great measure to the settlement of Minnesota and the building of a great state; and*
- WHEREAS: *Minnesota is rich in Scandinavian traditions and culture; and*
- WHEREAS: *Scandinavian entertainers, foremost among them Olle I. Skratthult, do epitomize the richness of this musical and ethnic heritage; and*
- WHEREAS: *for the second consecutive year, the Snoose Boulevard Festival will recapture those traditions through joyous music and entertainment of another era; and*
- WHEREAS: *on the last week-end in April, the Cedar-Riverside area in Minneapolis will vibrate with celebrants whose forebears came from the Scandinavian countries;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 27, 28 and 29, 1973 to be

SNOOSE BOULEVARD FESTIVAL DAYS

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to honor their Scandinavian friends and neighbors by joining them in the festivities during these memorable days.
