Resolved that this corporation being organized
for, and engaged in the mining, smelting, and
refining of copper ore in the state of Minnesota
do hereby accept all the provisions of the Act of
Legislature of the State of Minnesota entitled
"An act to encourage mining in the State of Minnesota
by providing a uniform rule for the taxation upon
mining property and products" approved November
22nd A. D. 1881; and agree to be bound thereby.

Resolved that a copy of the foregoing resolution
be made and certified by the Secretary of this
company under the seal thereof, and delivered to
the Secretary of State to be filed in pursuance
of the provisions of said legislative act.

On Motion of Jas Smith Jr. the foregoing resolutions
were unanimously approved and adopted.
