WHEREAS: the Professional Golfers' Association of America will sponsor the Twenty-First Annual NATIONAL GOLF DAY on Tuesday, May 29, 1973; and

WHEREAS: during the last twenty years, over \$1,800,000.00 has been realized from NATIONAL GOLF DAY for United Service Organizations, the American Red Cross, Caddie Scholarship Funds, the U. S. Blind Golfers Association, the National Amputee Golf Association, the Jaycee War Memorial Fund, Golf facilities at Veterans' Hospitals and Military installations, Turf Research and Education, Golf Professional Education, financial assistance to those in straitened circumstances who have devoted their lives to Golf; and

WHEREAS: this day in 1973 will offer all the Golfers of America an opportunity to again assist many of these worthy charities and projects, as well as an opportunity to compete against the men's and ladies' PGA Champions and USGA Open Champions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim Tuesday, May 30, 1973 to be
