

WHEREAS: the United Negro College Fund, a federation of forty predominantly Black colleges and universities, now has asked the assistance of all citizens in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: the UNCF goal in the State of Minnesota this year is \$275,000 and the kickoff is May 10, 1973; and

WHEREAS: many trained and qualified graduates of these institutions are residents of our state enriching the cultural, business and professional life of our Minnesota communities; and

WHEREAS: higher education, in the words of a prominent educator is the "Great equalizer of the conditions of men . . . the balance wheel of the social machinery; and

WHEREAS: without the institutions that comprise the United Negro College Fund thousands of disadvantaged young people would be deprived of their only hope of securing equal educational opportunities and, hence, of equality of opportunity upon graduation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1973

in the State of Minnesota, and I do urge all the citizens of our State to support generously this commendable project.
