Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 16.125, 16.13 and 16.135, the following administrative reorganization is hereby made effective July 1, 1973.

All licensing of livestock buyers and dealers functions, including annual license to operate, bonding coverage, and collecting of fee payments, of the Department of Public Services, Livestock Buyers and Dealers Division, are hereby transferred to the Department of Agriculture.

The Department of Agriculture shall hold public hearings and present findings to the Public Service Commissionnat the direction of the Commission regarding bond requirements; shall act as trustee for the licensing bonds; shall determine liability from default; and may decline to grant or may revoke a license under the provisions of M.S. 239.18, subd. 4. Claims for damages under M.S. 239.18, subd. 5 shall be submitted to the Department of Agriculture.

### Report and Recommendation Reorganization Orders 22, 23, 24 May 22, 1973

Reorganization orders 22, 23, and 24 transfer the: grain sampling, grading and analysis activities; livestock licensing and bonding activity; and livestock weighing activity of the Department of Public Service to the Department of Agriculture. The primary intent of these transfers is to promote the functional integration of activities related primarily to the protection and promotion of agriculture.

At the present time these three activities are located in the Grain Inspection, Livestock Buyers and Dealers, and Livestock Weighing Divisions of the Department of Public Service. In FY 1973 these activities are estimated to involve:

These figures are from Activity Analysis Part II and may not reflect more current information.

These reorganizations were requested by the Governor's Office in response to LEAP recommendations to consolidate agricultural oriented activities in the Department of Agriculture. In like manner, other LEAP recommendation advocate that the department divest itself of non-agricultural responsibilities, and these may be the subject of future reorganization orders. July 1, 1973 was selected as the date of transfer because of the convenience of making such changes with the establishment of new annual budgets for the ensuing fiscal year.

These reorganizations will not affect the methods or procedures of the activities being transferred. Improvements in them as recommended by LEAP or as otherwise developed will primarily be the responsibility of the Department of Agriculture.

However, the Department of Agriculture should be advised of the following points:

1. Continued use of current office supplies and inspection and weighing tickets with Public Service names seemingly present no major problems which would adversely affect daily operations. Some savings should result by not destroying current supplies. Also, there is some question whether Agriculture Department tickets could be obtained by July 1, 1973.

2. Office space and labs for the Grain Inspection and Local Grain Warehouse Divisions should remain at the Grain Exchange building in Minneapolis.

3. From previous investigations it appears that the licensing of livestock buyers and dealers and the livestock weighing

centralized activity could be housed in the Livestock Exchange Building, South St. Paul. This would place these activities near the industry they are regulating; as is now the case with the grain inspection division. Field operations should continue in their present locations for each activity.

4. Savings from these transfers could be generated by not filling the current vacant position of Director of Livestock Weighing Division.

These orders also combine, within the Department of Public Service, the Public Storage Warehouse and the Local Grain Warehouse Divisions into one Warehouse Division.

Attached to this report are appropriation accounts and dollar amounts to be transferred by reorganization orders numbers 22, 23 and 24.
