ORDINANCE NO. 582

(K-10)

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WILLMAR, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

Whereas, A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Willmar, a municipal corporation in the State of Minnesota by the sole owner having an interest therein, to have certain real property hereinafter described included within the limits of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and

Whereas, It is proposed to annex by virtue hereof to the said City of Willmar, said property, all of which said property is in Kandiyohi County, State of Minnesota, and

Whereas, The said property to be annexed consists of approximately 63 acres, more or less, described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 119, Range 35, lying Southeasterly of the Southeasterly right-of-way of Burlington Northern Railroad, except that part lying Westerly of the East 1,362.93 feet thereof; and except the North 468.63 feet of the East 440.20 feet thereof.

Now Therefore, The City Council of the City of Willmar hereby determines, ordains and declares as follows:

Section 1. Best Interest of the City of Willmar and Area to be Annexed. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.

Section 2. Abuts on City Limits. That the property above described abuts on the City limits, and is so conditioned as property to be subject to City government.

Section 3. Annexation. That the said property is hereby annexed to, and included within, the City of Willmar, Minnesota as effectually as if it has originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. Zoning. The area above described shall be zoned I-3, Industrial District.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be filed and shall take effect and be of full force and effect from and after filing a certificate thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County of Kandiyohi, Minnesota, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and from and after its passage and publication.
