### ORDINANCE NO. 19.13

# AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF BUFFALO WRIGHT COUNTY, MINNESOTA

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUFFALO ORDAINS:

#### SECTION ONE:

The Village Council finds that a Petition has been duly filed with the Village of Buffalo and the Council and Clerk thereof, of which Petition copies have been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, The Town Board of Buffalo Township, the County Board of Wright County, Minnesota and the Wright County Planning and Zoning Commission of Wright County, Minnesota, which Petition, being signed by all the property owners of the lands proposed to be annexed, requested that the lands hereinafter described be included within the Village of Buffalo which abuts upon such lands and that no other municipalities border the lands to be annexed; that after more than sixty (60) days had expired since such filing of such Petition no objection to such annexation had been submitted to the Minnesota Municipal Commission or to the Village of Buffalo, except that an objection to the proposed annexation was filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission on January 10, 1973 by the Town of Buffelo, such objection being withdrawn on April 19, 1973, and such objection being further dismissed by Order of the Minnesota Municipal Commission dated April 24, 1973; that there are now no objections to such annexation; that the premises so proposed to be amexed are situate in the State of Minnesota, County of Wright, and described as Pollows, to-wit:

Commencing at the center of Section 19, Township 120, Range 25; thence South on the quarter line 451.4 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue South on the quarter line 710 feet more or less to the right-of-way line of Trunk Highway #55; thence Northwesterly along said Trunk Highway #55 right-of-way line 500 feet; thence deflect 90° right 235 feet; thence continue in a Northeasterly direction to the point of beginning;

That such lands are unincorporated lands abuting on the Village of Buffalo and not included in any other municipality; that no part thereof has been platted; and that the total area of such territory is far less than two hundred acres; that such annexation will be to the best interests of the municipality of the Village of Buffalo, Wright County, Minnesota, and will be to the best interests of the territory affected and so proposed to be annexed.

That all statutory requirements for annexation have been completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDATIND AND DECLARED: That those premises situate in the State of Minnesota, County of Wright, described as above, are hereby annexed to the Village of Buffalo, Wright County, Minnesota.

Let copies of this Ordinance be filed pursuant to law.
