# EXTRACTS OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LINDSTROM CHISAGO COUNTY, MINNESOTA

A regular meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Lindstrom, Minnesota, duly called, convened, and held in accordance with law, was called to order by Mayor Kermit Carlson on the 12th day of April, 1973, at 7:00 P.M. at the Council Chambers in said village.

The following members, constituting a legal quorum were present:

Kermit W. Carlson Sig Stene Hedley Ward H.C. Branson David Ninnemann

Councilman Sig Stene introduced a certain Ordinance No. 116 entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LINDSTROM, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA, SAID LAND ABUTTING THE EXISTING VILLAGE LIMITS"

and moved its adoption.

The motion to adopt Ordinance No. 176 was seconded by Councilman H.C. Branson.

And upon roll call the vote was as follows:

Ayes: Carlson, Stene, Branson, Ward and Ninnemann Nays: None

The Mayor then decalred said motion duly carried and the above entitled Ordinance was duly passed and adopted, and ordered the Village Clerk to publish the same and to file certified copies of the same with the Secretary of State, County Auditor of Chisago County, The Town Clerk of Chisago Lake Township, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission in accordance with the law in such case made and provided.

## ORDINANCE NO. 116

AN ORDINALGE EXTERDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LINDSTROM, LUMINESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 AGRES IN AREA, SAID LAND ABUTTING THE EXISTING VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, A certain Potition dated Jamary 15, 1973, potitioning for the annountion of certain territory was duly presented to the Village Council of Lindstrom on the 30th day of Jamary, 1973.

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition did not exceed 200 acres, and consisted of platted and unplatted land, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Potition abuts upon the village limits of Lindstron on the easterly border thereof, and

thereas, said Petition was signed by all of the owners of the land proposed to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, Copies of said Potition have been filed with the Minnesota Limicipal Cormission, the Town Board of the Town of Chisago Lake, and the Chisago County Board of Commissioners; the land described in said Potition being entirely contained within the Town and County named herein, and

WHEREAS, no written objections to said annexation have been submitted to the Himnesota Municipal Commission or the Village of Lindstrom by the Chisago Lakes Town Board or by the Chisago County Board of Commissioners within Sixty (60) days after the filing of same, with the bedies named, and

WHIMEAS, no Potition for corporation or annovation is pending before the Municipal Commission which include any part or all of the land proposed to be annound and herein described, and NOV THEREFORE, The Council of the Village of Lindstrom, Minnesota, ordains as follows:

# Section 1. Council Determinations.

The Village Council hereby determines: (a) That the land described herein abute upon the Village limits of the Village of Lindstrom on its costorly border; (b) That said land is urban in character; (c) That the constation of said land will be to the best interest of the Village of Lindstrom and of the land affected; (d) That none of said territory is now included within the limits of any incorporated city, village, or becough; (e) That part of the land is platted and part is unplatted, and that the land in its entirety does not exceed 200 acres in area.

## Section 2. Territory Annound.

The corporate limits of the Village of Lindstrom are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted land described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village of Lindstrom the same as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Commencing hold foot North and 33 foot West of the Southeast Corner of Government Lot 6, Scotion 33, Tourship 34, Range 20, Chicago County. Manacota; themse West, Parallel to the South line of said Government Lot 6, to the shoreline of South Lindstron Lake; themse Northeasterly, along the shoreline of said South Lindstron Lake, to a point 759 feet North of the South line of Government Lot 6, measured perpendicularly thereto; themse East, parallel to the South Line of said Government Lot 6, to a point 33 feet West of the East line of said Government Lot 6; themse South, a distance of 275 feet to the point of beginning; subject to a public read over and across the East 33 feet of the described parcel.

#### Section 3. Filing.

The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Chisago Lake Township, the County Auditor of Chisago County, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

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Scation 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance takes offert upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3.
