

Acceptance. of the Grant of land made
by the Legislature of the Territory of Min-
nesota, to the Transit Rail Road Company.

Resolved.

That an act of the Legislature
of the Territory of Minnesota (Among
other things) granting lands to the Transit
Rail Road Company, to aid said Company,
to construct a Rail Road from Winona
via St. Peter to the Big Sioux River, south
of the forty fifth Paralell of North lat-
tude. Approved May twenty second,
one thousand Eight Hundred and fifty
seven, and to execute the trust created
by an act of Congress "making a grant
of land to the Territory of Minnesota in
alternate sections to aid in the construct-
ion of certain Rail Roads in the ^{said} Territory,
and granting Public lands in alternate sec-
tions to the state of Alabama, to aid in the
construction of a certain Rail Road in
said state," approved on the third day of
March, A.D. one thousand Eight-hundred
and fifty seven (March 3. 1857) and the grants
of the said act made to said Transit Rail Road
Company, be and the same are hereby accepted
and agreed to by said Company, upon the terms
and conditions, and according to the pro-
visions, in the said act contained.
