ORDINANCE NO. 2.07

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HENDRICKS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 acres IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, A certain petition dated May 11, 1973, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 15th day of May, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately 11.4 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the sole owner of the territory described below, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts upon the village limits at the east boundary thereof;

The council of the Village of Hendricks, Minnesota ordains:

<u>Section 1.</u> The village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Territory Annexed.</u> The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof; That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 112, Range 46, Lincoln County, Minnesota described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the West line of said Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter and the Easterly extension of the South line of Lincoln Street in the Village of Hendricks, plat of record and on file in the office of the Register of Deeds, Lincoln County, Minnesota; thence Southerly along the West line of said Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter a distance of 420.00 feet to the point of beginning of the parcel herein described; thence Easterly, deflecting to the left 90 degrees a distance of 370.00 feet; thence Southerly, parallel with said West line a distance of 868.01 feet to the South line of said Southwest Quarter; thence Westerly along said South line a distance of 29.07 feet to a point distant 341.00 feet from the Southwest corner of said Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter; thence North 64 degrees, 40 minutes West a distance of 373.74 feet to said West line (the South line of said Southwest Quarter having an assumed bearing of East); thence Northerly along said West line a distance of 715.49 feet to the point of beginning, subject to easements of record.

<u>Section 3.</u> Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the County Auditor and the Clerk of the Township of Hendricks.

<u>Section 4. Effective Date</u>. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3 above.
