ORDINANCE NO. 112

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF NORWOOD TO
INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS NOT
EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. A petition having been filed with the governing body of the Village of Norwood, by John M. O'Neill and Elisabeth O'Neill, his wife, and J. Fred Welter, the owners of the following described real estate, to have such lands included within the Village of Norwood, Minnesota:

Commencing at a point which point is 33 ft. South thence 1067.06 ft. East of the SW corner of the Northwest Quarter of Southwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 14-115-26; thence running South 180 feet to a point; thence running West 60 feet to a point; thence North 180 feet to a point; thence East 60 feet to place of beginning, all in said Section 14, Township 115, Range 26, Containing 25/100 acre more or less.

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 15, Township 115, Range 26; thence Wasterly along the South line of Lot 9 Schrupp's Addition to the Village of Norwood and continuing to a point on the North shore line of Brads Lake as established by the original government survey; thence Southwesterly along the said shore line of Brads Lake to a point which is at the South end of a projected line extending the East line of Schrupp's Addition from the Southeast corner of said Lot 9 to the shore line of Brads Lake; thence Northerly along the said extended line to the place of beginning. Containing one (1) acre of land more or less.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is 1.25 acres.

Section 3. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village of Norwood, Minnesota, and of the land affected; that the land described herein is unincorporated and situated on the Village of Norwood and is urban in nature or character and the Village of Norwood is capable of providing services required by the land being annexed.

Section 4. Therefore, the Village of Norwood, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Norwood, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
