CRDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HEW MUNICE TO DISCLUDE CERTAIN UNITCORPORATED UNPLATTED LANDS HOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

UNICIRAS, a cortain potition requesting amountion of the torritory horoinafter described was duly presented to the Council on March 5, 1973, and

MHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the potition and bounded as described is approximately 40 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, willage, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by two owners, constituting a majority but not all a total of three corners; and

UNEXEAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be amoved, and

MMMREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of New Manich, on the proposed annomition after at least 30 days mailed notice to all of the property owners, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the notition abouts upon the Village limits at the Southerly boundary thereof;

NCY THEREFORE, the Village Council of 'ne Village of New Munich, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines.

- (a. "hat the annexation will be to the hast interests of the Village and of the territory affected.
- (b.) That the territory described lerein abuts upon the Village limits and is about to become urban or sub-urban in character.
- (c.) That none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory ammered.

The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the unplatted lands described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been part thereof:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW-NE+) and of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE+NW+) of Section Nineteen (19), Township One Hundred Twenty Five (125; North of Range Thirty Two (32) West, Stearns County, Minresota, described as follows:

Dogiming at the intersection of the Southeasterly right-of-way line of the See Lie Reilread with the centerline of the State Aid Read Ho. 12 as now comotracted and travolod; themeo Seath along said conterline of State Aid Read No. 12 to its intersection with a line which is parallel to and Thirty Three (33) foot Southeasterly of the Southeasterly rightof Log limb of the See Limb Relired as neasured at right angles thereto: thomso Southwootorly in a straight line along said parallel line to its interpretation with a line which is parallel to and Five Mundred (500) foot work of the semiorlims of State Aid Read No. 12 as necessred at right angles thoroto; thouse South on said parallel line to the Bast-West quarter line of said Soction Dinotoon (19); thomas Westerly along said Curter line to the throad of the street of Sauk River; thouse Northwesterly along the throad of the strong to the Southeasterly right-of-way line of the Soc Lino Reilroad; thomso Northonstorly along said right-of-way line to the Wostorly lim of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SWHIEE); thonco Northerly along the Westerly line to the Village limit line of the Village of New Munich; thence Easterly along the Village limit line to the contorline of State Aid Road No. 12; themee Southerly along the contorline of State Aid Road Ne. 12 to the point of beginning.

Section 3. Filing.

The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minneseta Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the County Auditor, and the Register of Deeds.

Soction 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3.
