ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW MUNICH TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on March 5, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately 40 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by two owners, constituting a majority but not all a total of three owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of New Munich, on the proposed annexation after at least 30 days mailed notice to all of the property owners, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Village limits at the Southerly boundary thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Council of the Village of New Munich, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines.

(a.) That the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected.

(b.) That the territory described herein abuts upon the Village limits and is about to become urban or sub-urban in character.

(c.) That none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory annexed.

The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the unplatted lands described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been part thereof:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nineteen (19), Township One Hundred Twenty Five (125) North of Range Thirty Two (32) West, Stearns County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Southeastly right-of-way line of the See Line Railroad with the centerline of the State Aid Road No. 12 as now constructed and traveled; thence South along said centerline of State Aid Road No. 12 to its intersection with a line which is parallel to and Thirty Three (33) foot Southeastly of the Southeastly right-of-way line of the See Line Railroad as measured at right angles thereto; thence Southwestly in a straight line along said parallel line to its intersection with a line which is parallel to and Five Hundred (500) foot west of the centerline of State Aid Road No. 12 as measured at right angles thereto; thence South on said parallel line to the East-West quarter line of said Section Nineteen (19); thence Westly along said Quarter line to the thread of the stream of Sauk River; thence Northwestly along the thread of the stream to the Southeastly right-of-way line of the See Line Railroad; thence Northwestly along said right-of-way line to the Westly line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$); thence Northly along the Westly line to the Village limit line of the Village of New Munich; thence Easterly along the Village limit line to the centerline of State Aid Road No. 12; thence Southly along the centerline of State Aid Road No. 12 to the point of beginning.

Section 3. Filing.

The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the County Auditor, and the Register of Deeds.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3.
