ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND
TO THE VILLAGE OF AVON, IN STEARNS COUNTY,
MINNESOTA.

WHEREAS, a certain petition having been duly filed with the
Village Council in and for the Village of Avon, in Stearns County,
Minnesota, by a majority of the owners of certain real estate situate
in the County of Stearns and State of Minnesota, described as follows,
to-wit:

That part of Gov't Lot 4, Section 27, Township 125, Range 30,
Stearns County, Minnesota lying southerly of the southerly right
of way line of U. S. Highway 52 and further described as follows:
Commencing at the north quarter section corner of said section
27; thence North 00 degrees, 24 minutes and 34 seconds West
(assumed bearing) along the north-south quarter section line
for 1763.02 feet; thence South 76 degrees and 04 minutes West
for 1900.32 feet to the point of beginning of the land to be
described; South 13 degrees and 56 minutes East for 424.60
feet; thence North 76 degrees and 04 minutes East for 225.00
feet; thence North 13 degrees and 56 minutes West for 424.60
feet; thence South 76 degrees and 04 minutes West for 225.00
feet; thence South 76 degrees and 04 minutes West for 225.00
feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.19 acres.

petitioning that said real estate be annexed to the Village of Avon, Minnesota,
and,

WHEREAS, it was determined by said Village Council that said
real estate is unplatted land, is less than 200 acres, and abuts upon
the boundaries of the Village of Avon, and,

WHEREAS, upon receipt of said petition said Village Council
filed copies of the same with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the
Stearns County Board of Commissioners and Township Board of Avon,
and within thirty days of said filing there were no written objections to
said annexation submitted to the Village of Avon or to the Minnesota
Municipal Commission, excepting objection on the part of the Township
of Avon, which objection was thereafter withdrawn, and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by said Village Council that said annexation will be in the best interest of the Village of Avon and the above described property,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Council in and for the Village of Avon does hereby declare and ordain:

That the corporate limits of the Village of Avon, in Stearns County, Minnesota, be and they hereby are extended to include that certain real estate hereinbefore described, and the same is hereby annexed and included in the Village of Avon as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Village Clerk file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Stearns County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, publication and the filing of certified copies as hereinbefore directed.
