WHEREAS: Orville C. Peterson is Minnesota's leading authority on municipal government; and

WHEREAS: Orville C. Peterson has influenced and guided the enactment of progressive legislation affecting municipalities during the last three decades; and

WHEREAS: Orville C. Peterson has been the recipient of many academic honors, has served on many advisory commissions, boards of directors, committees; and
