WHEREAS: Orville C. Peterson is Minnesota' leading authority on municipal government; and

WHEREAS: Orville C. Peterson has influenced and guided the enactment of progressive legislation affecting municipalities during the last three decades; and

WHEREAS: Orville C. Peterson has been the recipient of many academic honors, has served on many advisory commissions, boards of directors, committees; and

WHEREAS: Orville C. Peterson is the author of numerous publications, including "Tort Liability Aspects of Governmental Efforts to Relieve Urban Traffic Congestion," widely used and quoted throughout the country; and

WHEREAS: Orville C. Peterson is retiring as a member of the faculty of the School of Public Affairs, University of Minnesota on Tuesday, May 29, 1973;
