

The Chicago, St. Paul and Kansas City Railway Company,
a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Iowa,
being desirous of doing business within the State of Minnesota,
operating railroads within that State, and of possessing all the
powers, franchises and privileges, and becoming subject to the
same liabilities as railroad companies organized and incorporated
under the general laws of said State of Minnesota, hereby for that
purpose accepts the provisions of an act of the legislature of
Minnesota, being Section 1 of chapter 27 of the General Laws of
1873, amended by Section 1, chapter 14 of the General Laws of
Minnesota for 1877, the same being Section 106 of chapter 34 of
the General Statutes of Minnesota of 1879.

executed by its president, with its corporate seal attached, duly
attested by its secretary, this 7th day of January 1888.
