

WHEREAS: men and women of the Minneapolis Air Route Traffic Control Center will be cited by the Federal Aviation Administration on June 25 and presented an award for operating the outstanding Air Route Traffic Control Center in the United States during 1972; and

WHEREAS: much credit for the smooth overall operation of the center must go to the Air Traffic Controllers whose responsibility required the highest type of alertness and dedication; and

WHEREAS: last year the Minneapolis Air Route Traffic Control Center had many accomplishments the greatest being the smooth acquisition of a large parcel of airspace previously controlled by another facility. That additional workload, along with the normal increase in air traffic, increased their total operations 58.9 percent over 1971;
