PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: the Young World Development program of the American Freedom From Hunger Foundation, through the Walk for Development and other activities, exemplifies a positive and constructive youth effort to solve the problems of poverty and hunger in the United States and the world; and

WHEREAS: American youth in more than 150 cities will, during the month of May, 1973, participate in a National Walk for Development to show their commitment to efforts that will allow poor and hungry people throughout the world the opportunity to overcome their poverty and hunger; and

WHEREAS: this is an effort to bridge the gap between rich and poor countries, thus promoting social and economic justice and world peace; and

WHEREAS: thousands of youth in many Minnesota communities will participate in this national demonstration of concern for the world's poor and hungry;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the weekend of May 5 and 6, 1973, to be

WALK FOR DEVELOPMENT WEEK-END

in Minnesota, and commend this observance to all citizens.
