- WHEREAS: *the Union-Industries Show is an annual national exposition held in a different major metropolitan area to display the fact that Labor and Management work together for the common good; and*
- WHEREAS: *the theme of this exhibition, "Progress through Cooperation," vividly underscores the point that Labor and Management combine to make America and Minnesota a better place for all to live and work; and*
- WHEREAS: *this Show clearly demonstrates the ingenuity and quality of the American free enterprise system by unveiling a miniature open house of America at work; and*
- WHEREAS: *the 1973 AFL-CIO Union-Industries Show will be at the Minneapolis Auditorium and Convention Hall from June 15 through 20 from 1:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. to afford the general public an opportunity to see a unique exposition that is attractive, interesting and educational;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 15 through 20, 1973 as

in Minnesota, and further direct the attention of our citizens to the Union-Industries Show, which mirrors the spirit of cooperation between the two basic elements of the American system of free enterprise.
