

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS: the Village of Easton was platted in 1873, its first residents having journeyed to this area 17 years before, soon after the Treaty of Traverse Des Sioux, and established a settlement called Honor's Grove; and
- WHEREAS: one of Easton's special landmarks are hardwood trees over miles of grassy prairie; and
- WHEREAS: Easton, through soil, love and its famous rich, black soil, has emerged as one of the state's best farm areas; and
- WHEREAS: Easton, in this Centennial Year, will now and forever be known as the Agri-Heart of Southern Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: the civic pride evidenced by Easton's Centennial Celebration on June 23-24 is true testimony of this city's vitality and faith in the future;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June to be

CENTENNIAL DAYS IN EASTON

and urge all citizens of Minnesota to herald the events proclaiming Easton's 100th Anniversary and just claim to fame as the Agri-Heart of Southern Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this first day of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three and of the State, the one hundred and fifteenth.
