ORDINANCE NO. 237
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE
OF FOREST LAKE

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the sole owner of the territory described below petitioned the Village Council of the Village of Forest Lake on May 14, 1973 to annex the territory described below to the village of Forest Lake, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Forest Lake on May 14, 1973 and served by mail upon the Washington County Board of Commissioners, Forest Lake Town Board, and Minnesota Municipal Commission, by mailing same to them on the 29th day of May, 1973, the said Village Council expressed its intention to annex the territory described below to the Village of Forest Lake, and

WHEREAS, no objections have been received from any party as to the proposed annexation,

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST LAKE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The corporate limits of the Village of Forest Lake are hereby extended to include the property legally described as follows:

That part of Government Lot 1 of Section 16, Township 32 North, Range 21 West, Washington County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Government Lot 1; thence East, along the north line of Government Lot 1, a distance of 600 feet; thence South 31 degrees 00 minutes East, a distance of 129 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing South 31 degrees 00 minutes East, a distance of 30 feet; thence South 44 degrees 04 minutes East, a distance of 120 feet, more or less, to the shoreline of a channel; thence Forest Lake; thence northeasterly, along the shoreline of said channel, a distance of 215 feet, more or less, to the shoreline of Forest Lake; thence northwesterly, along said shoreline, a distance of 86 feet, more or less, to the point of intersection with a line that bears North 74 degrees 12 minutes East from the point of beginning; thence South 74 degrees 12 minutes West, distance of 240 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

AND: A 33-foot strip of land lying adjacent to the southwesterly lines of the above tract and southerly of the westerly extension of the north line of the above tract and northerly of the channel. The above tracts contain a total of 0.7 acre, more or less, and includes a perpetual, non-exclusive easement over a 33-foot strip of land the northerly and northeasterly lines are described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north line of Government Lot 1 distant 413.5 feet East of the northwest corner; thence continuing East, along said north line, a distance of 186.5 feet; thence South 31 degrees 00 minutes East, a distance of 129 feet and there terminating, the south line to be the north line of the above tract.

SECTION 2. The Village Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance, together with the Affidavit of Publication thereof with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Washington County, Minnesota, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and its publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in the above Section hereof.
