Proclamation

- WHEREAS: *the Minnesota Army and Air National Guard are an integral part of the Armed Forces of the United States of America for national defense; and*
- WHEREAS: *those Minnesotans presently serving in the Minnesota Army and Air National Guard are making a meaningful contribution to the economy, development and security of their community, state and nation; and*
- WHEREAS: *the need exists today for other Minnesotans to volunteer and serve with the Minnesota Army and Air National Guard and become actively involved in the affairs of their community, state and nation;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 14 - 20, 1973 as
