

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: August first is being observed as Inter-City United Sports Day, launching a year-round promotion of sportsmanship in race, religion, business, politics, domestic and foreign relations; and

WHEREAS: on this occasion special tribute will be paid to sports editors, sports writers and sportscasters while honoring, in each community, local, national and international sports stars; and

WHEREAS: adults and juveniles will be urged to pledge that they will both promote and practice sportsmanship because it can materially help check the increase in hate, terror, violence, vandalism, arson and murder; and

WHEREAS: the subject of sportsmanship is a desirable element in the curriculum of every school in America, especially the elementary and nursery schools;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, August 1, 1973 as

I-C-U SPORTS DAY

in Minnesota and urge the participation of all citizens in the effort.
