- WHEREAS: *Minnesota is a leader in the quality of life it provides its citizens; and*
- WHEREAS: *this ranking demonstrates a concern and effort by the citizens of this state toward improving the total environment, educating and encouraging its youth, and providing for the overall needs of people; and*
- WHEREAS: *cooperative businesses along with corporations, partnerships, and proprietorships strive to do their share in improving the quality of life for people within the framework of the private enterprise system; and*
- WHEREAS: *cooperatives serve farmers and consumers alike, for the processing and marketing of agricultural products and for the purchase of goods and services by consumers; and*
- WHEREAS: *by providing jobs, capital investments, competitive prices, quality control and new products development, and by returning earnings to local owners, these cooperative businesses contribute substantially to our agricultural progress and general economic and social development;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1973 as

CO-OP MONTH

and urge all Minnesotans to recognize the economic and democratic values of cooperatives and the care they have shown in improving the quality of life for all the people of our state.
